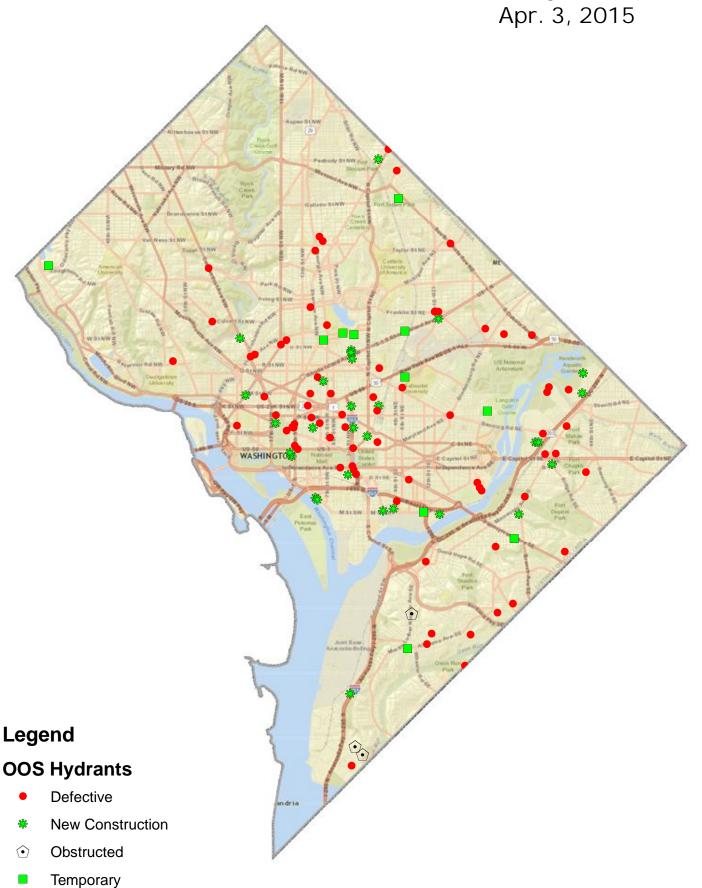
#### Status of Private Fire Hydrants-Based on FEMS Inspection Reporting
